PI/CPC: Heidi and Sarah had a meeting with Judge Bustamante in Levy County and probation officers from Levy County. It was a good meeting with the judge asking us to get together with the probation department again to help determine how many meetings the judge should sentence DUI offenders to. We have a second meeting with Judge Bustamante on Wed. March 18th.

Where and When: Sarah brought 25 for PI and 25 for groups.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Chiefland Reflections meeting is not being opened and DuWayne checked it out. He also called to try and talk to Mike W. who had been GSR and was opening. No contact was made. DuWayne will go to the meeting again and the decision was to give the meeting 30 days before removing it from the W&W. He also suggested we update the W&W by adding an asterisk and a note saying the meeting is at the North end of the building, called the Annex.
2. District needs a new Treasurer. All of the banking issues have been resolved, with Todd M. being removed as a signor. Online access is now available so that the statements can be retrieved in

Online Banking. Sarah H. offered to swap if someone would like to be secretary, she'd stay on as Treasurer. Please announce this at your meetings.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Char spoke up about making amends to Michael C. with regard to the Trenton Meridian meeting on Wednesday nights at 7. She and Michael have made peace and Char will now be the backup opener for the meeting.
2. DuWayne brought up the district phone and that it's important to pass the phone around to different groups like we used to do. Johnny C. will call Dan R. and will get the phone back to bring next month to the meeting.
3. Ray asked for reimbursement for the cost of the case of 20 Big Books. He brought with him a very detailed and historic treasurer report for PI. The balance in the PI fund was \$63.68 and the books cost \$247.80 which resulted in a negative balance of \$184.12. Motion was made to reimburse Ray for \$184.12, 2nd and passed.
4. Tisa said the Valentine's party at St. Alban's had about 12 people in attendance. It was basically a group party, not a district party.
5. St. Patrick's Day Party is being planned as a District event. Mandy said money for food and dry goods is needed. There was discussion about how much. Sarah looked back thru last year's treasurer reports to see what was spent last year, which was over \$300. Discussion concluded that \$200 should be ample. Motion made and passed.
6. Discussion about the Pink Can – is this money to be used for PI, CPC and Corrections? There were many opinions as to how District should divide the Pink Can money up. No one knows for sure whether this is mentioned in the Bylaws so it was tabled until next month when we could have more accurate information and perhaps decide on just how the Pink Can money is to be used by the District.
