PI/CPC: Sarah reported for CPC. We had the second meeting with Judge Bustamante (Levy County sitting judge) & his decision is to require 1st time DUI offenders 4 meetings over 1 month, 2nd time DUI 12 meetings over 3 months and TBD for 3rd time offenders. The probation officers were there too and they seemed a lot more supportive of ordering DUI offenders to attend AA meetings. Judge said we need to get ready because he's sending people our way! No future meeting with him was scheduled. Heidi and I still want to try to get a meeting into the Levy County jail. We also met with Kathleen O'Brien, a social worker who holds an Anger Mgmt Class at the probation office in Levy County on Monday afternoons and a Life Skills program on alternating Mondays. Heidi and I are going to do an AA presentation there on Monday, May 11th.

The Bylaws needs to be amended to reflect the motion made a few months ago that District will pay for 1 night's hotel room for GSR's or Alternates at an Area Assembly.
4. Mandy will take the District phone for the next month.
5. Mandy requested money for Spring Picnic food. \$135 was suggested and a motion was made and passed.

7. Change the Bylaws for DCM, Alt DCM for the Area Assembly hotel room to be the cost of the room, not a fixed dollar amount.
